Pre-Baptism Class Requirements

At the time of registration, the following documents are required (ALL ORIGINALS):

Completed application.

PARENT REQUIREMENTS

1. Parent(s) – original birth certificate from a county courthouse.

ROMAN CATHOLIC GODPARENT REQUIREMENTS

2. Documents needed: Original documents only:
 - Baptism
 - First Communion
 - Confirmation certificate
 - If married, marriage certificate from a Roman Catholic Church.
3. Godparents must be practicing Catholics who are at least 16 years of age.
4. Godparent cannot be the child's parent.
5. If the godparent is married (to each other or someone else), they need to be married by the Roman Catholic Church.
6. A godparent who has been married in the Catholic Church and later divorced, but never remarried or living with a partner may be a godparent.
7. If the godparents are single, they cannot be living with a partner.
8. Only one godparent is required. If two will participate, they must be male and a female, (not 2 males or 2 females) *Canon Law 873 NO EXCEPTIONS.*

CHRISTIAN WITNESS REQUIREMENTS

9. Documents needed: Original documents only:
 - Baptism Certificate required.

While it is not possible for a non-Catholic to serve as a godparent, a non-Catholic who is a baptized Christian in a protestant denomination may serve as a Christian witness to the Baptism.

There is a \$25.00 fee (per person)- which includes the following.

- Baptismal preparation class for the parents and godparents (ONLY).
- The class is valid for 2 years.
