

Where Heaven and Earth Meet

Have you ever noticed that mountains and clouds seem to “go together”? When I was a child, I thought it was because the mountains’ height pierced the sky. Turns out, it’s a bit more complicated. Mountains “create” their own clouds. When moving air comes across a mountain front, it forces the warm air to rise to cooler zones and water droplets in the air to condense. The phenomenon is so common that these clouds have their own name: lenticular. They are known for being bright—even colorful—with rays of light peeking out from behind. It’s no wonder why, throughout history, people have sought to ascend mountains as part of their spiritual journey. It was a way to get closer to the “heavens”—to those radiant clouds. Recall the prophet Elijah, who climbs Mount Sinai seeking a face-to-face encounter with God. Or Moses, who, with three of his closest friends, ascends Mount Sinai to meet God in a radiant cloud that hovers over the top of the peak. So, it’s also no wonder why Jesus, with three of *his* closest friends, might also climb a mountain and meet Elijah and Moses there. No wonder why that mountain would be covered in a bright cloud that thunders with God’s voice, and why, in that moment, Scripture describes heaven and earth as mysteriously yet visibly mingling in the person of the transfigured Jesus. The story of the transfiguration reminds us that just like mountains and clouds were meant for one another, heaven and earth were meant for one another. Jesus stands at the point where the two meet. **Reflection: What places or moments in my life have made me feel close to heaven?**

Donde el Cielo y la Tierra se Encuentran

¿Alguna vez has notado que las montañas y las nubes parecen ir “juntas”? Cuando era niño, pensaba que era porque la altura de las montañas atravesaba el cielo. Resulta que es un poco más complicado. Las montañas “crean” sus propias nubes. Cuando el aire en movimiento cruza una montaña, obliga al aire cálido a subir hacia zonas más frías y a condensar las gotas de agua en el aire. El fenómeno es tan común que estas nubes tienen su propio nombre: lenticular. Son conocidos por ser brillantes—incluso coloridos—con rayos de luz que se asoman por detrás. No es de extrañar que, a lo largo de la historia, la gente haya buscado ascender montañas como parte de su viaje espiritual. Era una forma de acercarse a los “cielos”—a esas nubes radiantes. Recuerda al profeta Elías, que sube al monte Sinai buscando un encuentro cara a cara con Dios. O Moisés, que, junto a tres de sus amigos más cercanos, asciende al monte Sinai para encontrarse con Dios en una nube radiante que se alza sobre la cima de la cima. Así que tampoco es de extrañar que Jesús, junto a tres de *sus* amigos más cercanos, también pudiera escalar una montaña y encontrarse allí con Elías y Moisés. No es de extrañar que esa montaña estuviera cubierta por una nube brillante que retumbara con la voz de Dios, y por qué, en ese momento, las Escrituras describen el cielo y la tierra como misteriosa pero visiblemente mezclados en la persona del Jesús transfigurado. La historia de la transfiguración nos recuerda que, así como las montañas y las nubes estaban destinadas la una a la otra, el cielo y la tierra estaban hechos el uno para el otro. Jesús está en el punto donde ambos se encuentran. **Reflexión: ¿Qué lugares o momentos de mi vida me han hecho sentir cerca del cielo?**
